Letters and Sounds Programme

Green Lane follows the Letters and Sounds Programme which follows a systematic, synthetic phonic approach to early reading. Children are taught to use phonics as the route to decoding words. Our aim is to provide children with reading books that are carefully matched to their phonic phase.

The focus then moves to that of comprehension and developing a deeper understanding of texts.

Reading is prioritised to allow pupils to access the full curriculum on offer at Green Lane. We follow a rigorous, sequential approach to reading which develops pupils' fluency, confidence and enjoyment in reading.
