Hello Little Buds and Nursery children,





Let's make

A lot of you love playing with the playdough in nursery. Here is a simple recipe that you could use to make your own playdough.

Ingredients 1 cup - Salt 2 cups - Plain Flour 4 table spoons – Cream of Tartar 2 table spoons – Cooking Oil 2 cups – Boiling Water Food Colouring


Carefully, mix all the ingredients in a large bowl. Grown ups – make sure you pour the boiling water into the bowl.

If you keep the playdough in an airtight container / plastic box with a lid, it should last for a couple of weeks!
