Talk Question

The weather has changed a lot recently. Some days it has been sunny and other days its been rainy and windy.

Can you familiarise yourself with coins and their values. See what different coins you can collect. What are they worth? Ask an adult to help you. Then draw them! (there is also some pictures if you don't have any coins to help you)

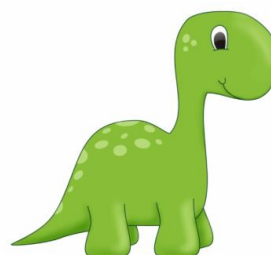

Writing

Can you remember your time words? Can you use these (first, next, then, finally) and try and sequence the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. You can either write it down or say it out loud to a family member.

Keep on writing in your diary about what you have been doing and write 3 sentences a day. Don't forget to include what the weather has been like each day.

Can you add the days of the week to your diary?

Can you write out all your alphabet in lowercase and uppercase?



Reading

Remember to read a range of books every day and ask questions throughout. Please log into bug club (as mentioned above) for a range of books for your child.

Remember you can make it fun by reading to a cuddly toy.

Can you design your own bookmark? Maybe you could decorate it with anything you have at home.

Do you have any stories that are about the weather?

Take a book and go read outside in the lovely weather!



Phonics

This week focus on the ue, ew and u-e sounds. Can you write some sentences with these words on the paper provided? For example, 'I **blew** the bubbles'

blue chew

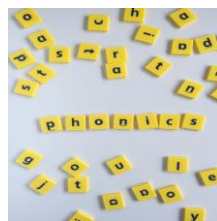

Exercise

2nd challenge – Throw a ball in the air, turn around and catch it. You get 1 point for trying and 1 point if you catch it.

3rd challenge – This one is harder! Throw a ball then lay down and catch it. You get 1 point for trying and 2 points if you catch it.

Play with all members of your family and have fun!

Top tips for home learning

- Try and stick to a routine. Encourage your child to understand the time when these things take place. For example, 'it's bedtime, and bedtime is at 7 o'clock'.
- Limit screen time each day and set times. Use screen time as an incentive.
- Make it fun and exciting.
- Give your child some 'downtime' to relax.
- Keep learning short – short 10-minute bursts are more effective.
- Read every day! Whether its with you, on their own or with a teddy.

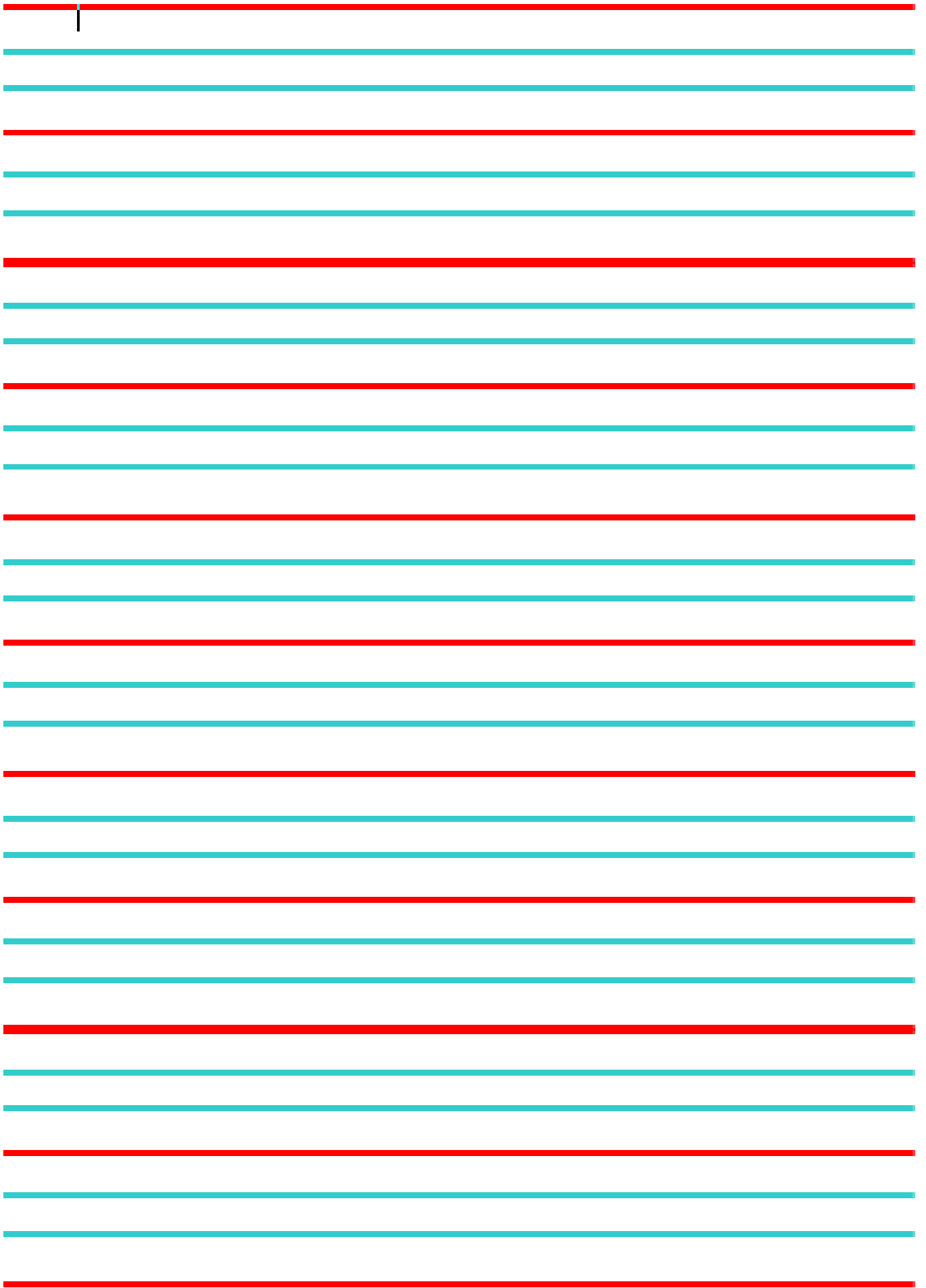

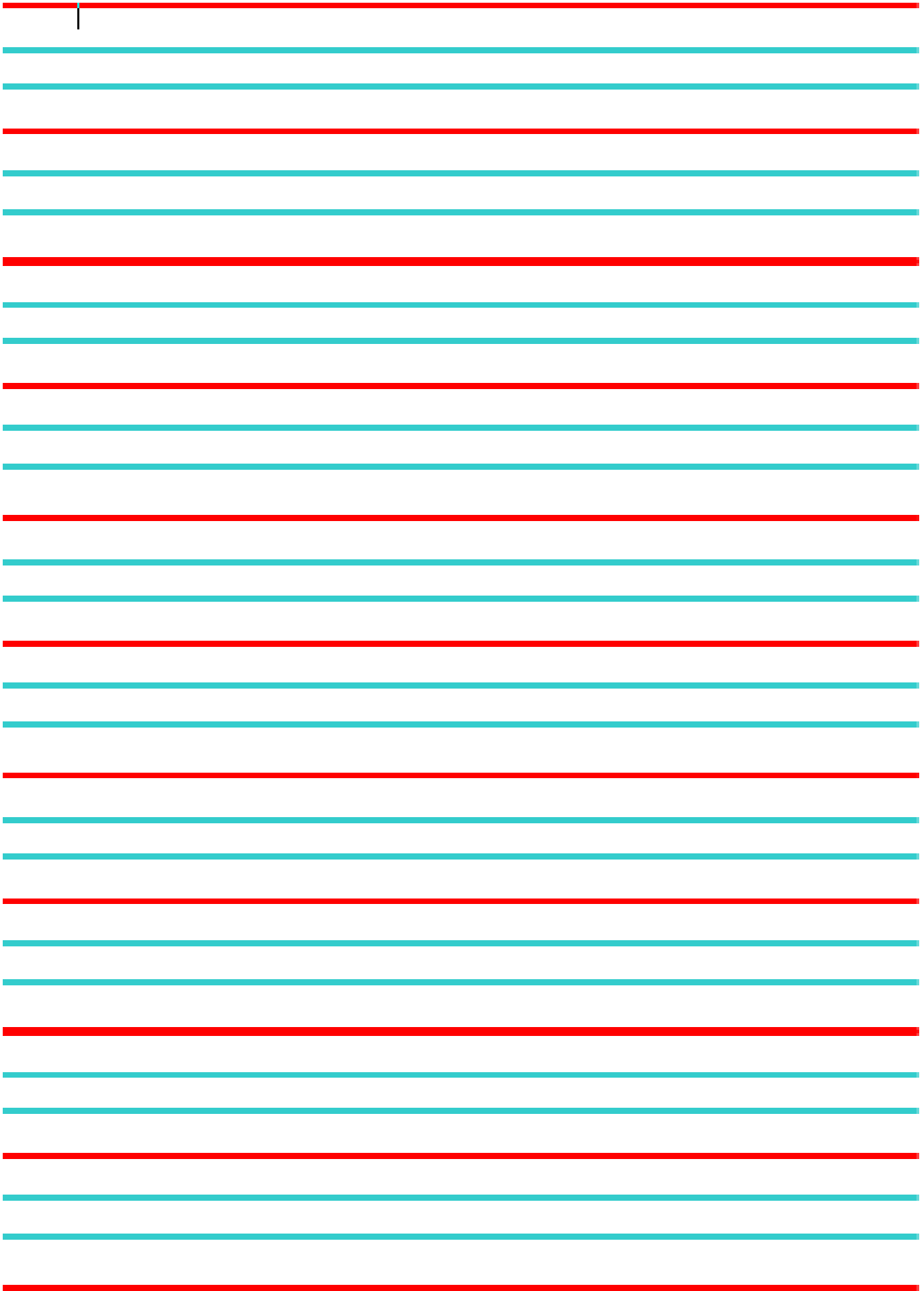


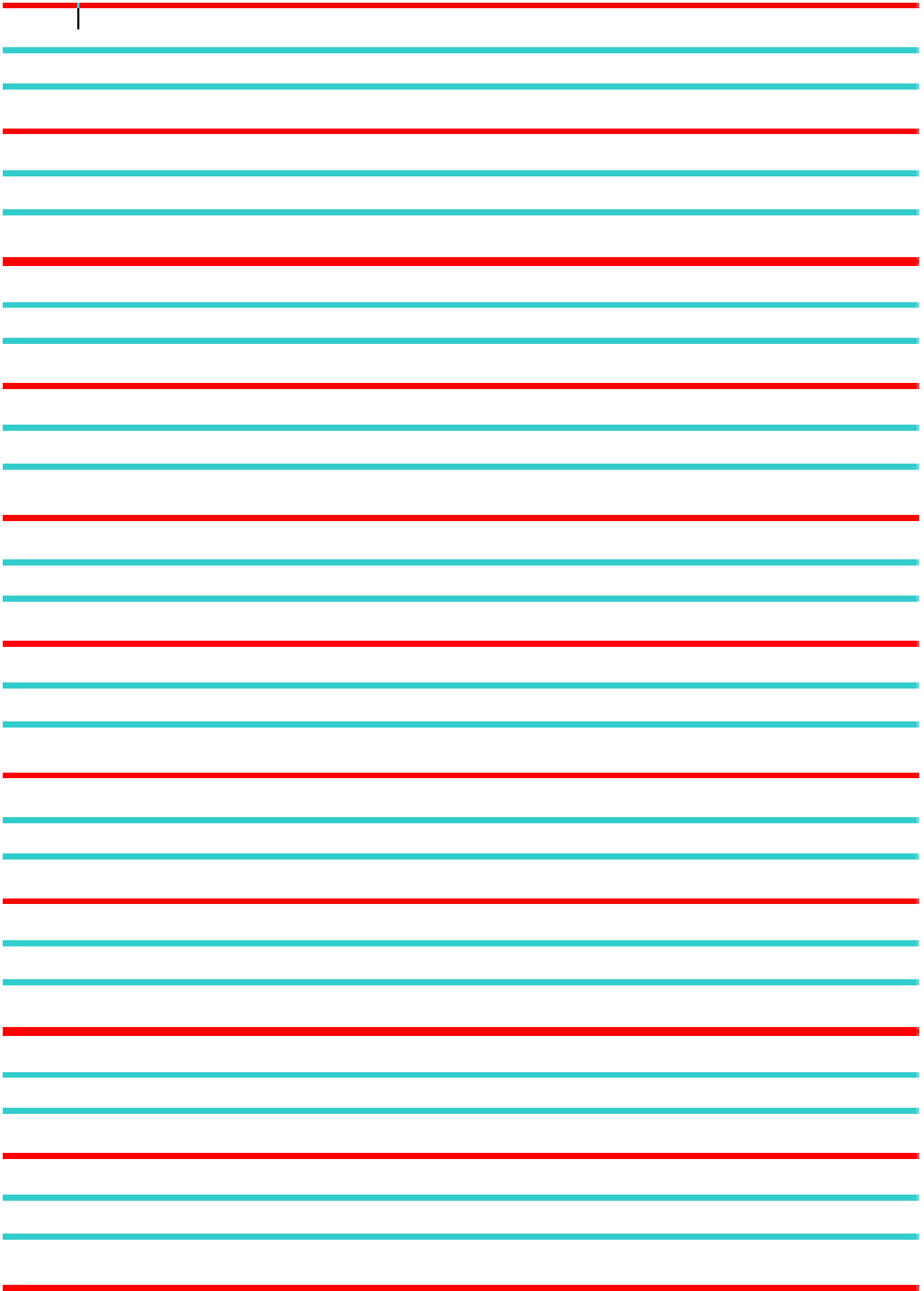
