

## History – Shopping

### What I already know....

- That the past is what has already happened
- That important things have happened to them and their families in the past
- That we can use words to help us understand the past like before, earlier, last week/month/year, yesterday, .....week etc ago
- That things do not stay the same but change as time passes eg. get older, grow, go to school, get married
- That people can die due to getting older

### Key Vocabulary

**Goods/produce** – a physical thing that you can pick up eg. a banana, a telly, a toy car

**Money** – a piece of paper or metal coin that is worth a certain amount

**Supermarket** – a very large shop selling food and other things that can be found all over the country

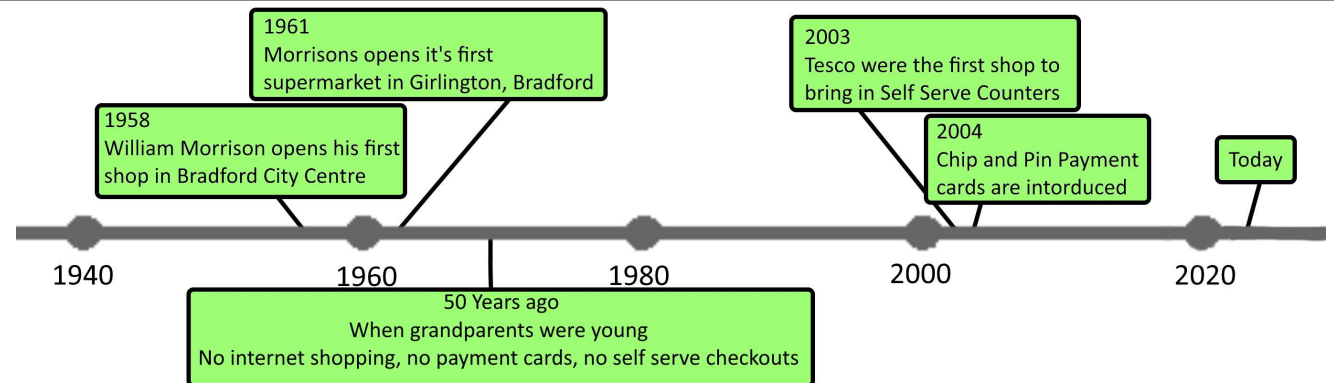
**Corner shop** – a very small shop selling sweets, a few food items (maybe meat) that is near your house  
Bakers, butchers, chemist, take away/restaurant, clothes shop – all usually smaller shops selling one particular type of item

**Checkout counter** – the place in a shop where you pay with money (using a card maybe) for the items you want to buy

**Internet shopping** – buying goods or services using a phone or a computer instead of going to the shop

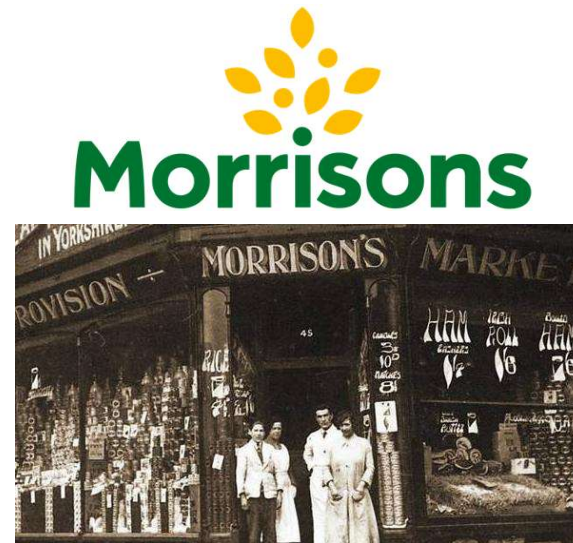
**Bank card** – a card that lets you buy what you want and lets the shopkeeper take the money from your bank later

### Key Facts

- You have to pay someone else if you want to get (purchase) something eg. a physical item or a service
- People used to have physical money, notes or coins, to be able to buy something.
- You used to have to physically go to the shop to be able to buy something
- You used to usually have to take the bought items home yourself
- You used to have to be served by someone in a shop and could not buy something yourself
