Our Learning next half term Ancient Egypt Forces and Magnets

English: Throughout this half term, we will be looking at the story 'Marcy and the Riddle of the Sphinx'. We will be exploring the characters thoughts and feelings. Our main focus this half term is explanatory writing and this will be supported by exploring the story through a variety of teaching approaches such as a role on the wall, writing a short letter, writing in role and doing some role play. Throughout the unit, children will be engaging in authentic writing for different purposes, particularly as part of the History curriculum. The content will support children in developing their historical literacy skills, deepening their knowledge of Ancient Egypt inspired by the events, settings and characters in this fictional adventure story and practising the skills and behaviours associated with being an historian.



Reading:

We will be exploring a range of texts through a strategy called VIPERS. VIPERS stands for the reading skills: Vocabulary, Inference, Prediction, Explanation, Retrieval and Summarise. These are the key areas which we feel children need to know and understand in order to improve their comprehension of texts







Science:

Forces and Magnets

This half term we will be learning about forces and magnets. We will explore different materials and whether they are magnetic or non-magnetic through scientific investigations. Alongside this we will learn about the magnetic pole and how they work. Later on we will explore the forces such as push and pull and carry out experiments.

Art

We will learn about primary and secondary colours and how to mix colours that we want to use. We will learn how to produce a background wash and use a range of brushes to create different effects. We will experiment using different colours We will also work with clay and Papier Mache to create a simple 3d objects. We will learn about sculptor Barbara Hepworth, Painter JWM Turner and Japanese artist Hokusai.

History

We will be learning about ancient civilisations in different parts of the world and comparing them. We will learn about Ancient Egypt, the Pyramids and how the Ancient Egyptian civilisation ended. We will be asking questions about History, and looking for information using different sources. This will include the internet, non- fiction books and what we might already know.



Project

We want our children to be super creative over the holidays. We'd like all the children in year 3 to have a go at some of these ideas. What could you put on your class display?

- **Research** Find different materials like wood, plastic and cotton and see if it is magnetic.
- **Picture** Draw a picture of a pyramid and Tutankhamun.
- Writing Can you explain how magnets work?
- Reading Find some information about Ancient Egypt
- Model Make model of a Pyramid.
- Drama Imagine you are an archaeologist excavating a pyramid.
- Make Make mummy with any recycle materials and cover with white tissue/fabric.

Do anything fun and creative and tell us about it. Post pictures on your class Purple Mash blog or just write about what you have done.
